The Marshfield Lions Club of Marshfield, Wisconsin, has established a scholarship fund in memoriam to Edward W. Heller, a good man who devoted 46 years of his life to journalism. Mr. Heller, who died in 1988, was former editor of the Marshfield News-Herald.

1. A Marshfield, Wisconsin, area resident.
2. A full-time undergraduate student entering the junior or senior year of college, with a major in communication arts, preferably journalism, or other media
3. A full-time postgraduate student majoring in journalism, or
4. An individual pursuing postgraduate work in journalism on either a full or part-time basis.
