Grace Annette Caliebe was born on July 23, 1922, in Appleton, Wisconsin the daughter of George and Mabel (Benson) Caliebe. In 1934, her family moved to Greenwood where she completed her education, graduating from Greenwood High School in 1939.



Grace then moved to Chicago where she attended the Lutheran Deaconess School of Nursing. Upon completing her nursing degree, she went to work at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Hines, Illinois. Grace later continued her education at the University of Wisconsin-Madison where she completed her Master's Degree in Nursing.

She then taught nursing at the city school of nursing in Chicago for many years and also continued to work at the V.A. Hospital in Hines on the weekends. She retired from teaching and took a full-time position in administration at the V.A. until retiring in 1992. After her retirement, she moved back to Greenwood to take care of her mother.

She was a member of Our Saviors' Lutheran Church and the U.S. Cadet Nurse Corps, enjoying traveling and was active in many veterans' organizations.

She was 87 when she passed at the Clark County Health Care Center in Owen on September 7, 2009.

Grace Caliebe generously remembered Marshfield Area Community Foundation in her estate planning, and her gift will be placed in the Grace A. Caliebe Greenwood Scholarship Fund. Each year, this fund will support a Greenwood High School graduate as they pursue a degree in the field of health care, sciences, mathematics, or engineering.
