



Seidl Scholarship

Members of the Seidl Family established a fund through the Marshfield Area Community Foundation to encourage young people to enter the field of agriculture, and to give back to the community that helped them build a successful business. The scholarship offers financial assistance to a full-time student pursuing a degree in agriculture or an agriculture related field (For example; Agronomy, Agri-Business, Soil Science, Animal Nutrition, Large Animal Veterinarian). To be eligible the successful candidate must:

1. Be a senior graduating from Marshfield High School.
2. The applicant must be scheduled to be enrolled as an undergraduate on a full-time basis at a four year accredited college or university during the next succeeding term.
3. The applicant must have at least a 3.0 grade point average (on a 4.0 scale)
4. Financial need will be considered but shall not be the determining factor in awarding the scholarship.
5. Applicant must answer all questions and have asked for letters of endorsement from two adults (see application form.)
6. Scholarships may be used only for tuition and fees required for attendance, and for course-related expenses (fees, books, supplies and equipment required for courses of instruction) and will be paid after the successful completion of the student's first semester upon showing proof of a 3.0 college grade point and proof of enrollment for second semester.

One \$750 Scholarship will be awarded second semester of freshman year.
