



Tom Drendel Scholarship

The family of Tom Drendel has established an endowment fund through the Marshfield Area Community Foundation to encourage young people to enter the field of agriculture, and to give back to the community.” The scholarship offers financial assistance to a full-time student pursuing a degree in agriculture or an agriculture related field (For example; Agronomy, Agri-Business, Soil Science, Animal Nutrition, Large Animal Veterinarian). To be eligible the successful candidate must:

1. Be a senior graduating from Auburndale, Marshfield, Spencer, Pittsville or Stratford High School or a nontraditional student and live within the geographical service area of the Marshfield Area Community Foundation.
2. The applicant must be scheduled to be enrolled as an undergraduate on a full-time basis at a four year accredited college or university, technical college or certificate program
3. The applicant must have at least a 3.0 grade point average (on a 4.0 scale)
4. Financial need will be considered but shall not be the determining factor in awarding the scholarship.
5. Applicant must answer all questions and have asked for letters of endorsement from three adults (see application form.) One of those letters must speak to the applicants ability to succeed in the agriculture field.

One \$1,000 Scholarship will be awarded second semester of freshman year.
