



Gordon and Faith Vine Family Scholarship

In honor of Gordon and Faith Vine, family and friends have established an endowment fund through the Marshfield Area Community Foundation to encourage young people to enter the field of education and/or agriculture. Gordon Vine born in 1923 and a 1940 graduate of Neillsville High School is the Great Grandson of Fred J. Vine, one of the earliest residents of the Neillsville area, homesteading on Pleasant Ridge, five miles East of Neillsville in the 1860's. Faith Vine, wife of Gordon, was an English and Reading Specialist at Neillsville High School. The scholarship offers financial assistance to a full-time student pursuing a degree in education or agriculture or an agriculture related field. To be eligible the successful candidate must:

1. Be a senior graduating from Neillsville High School.
2. The applicant must be scheduled to be enrolled as an undergraduate on a full-time basis at a four year accredited college or university during the next succeeding term.
3. The applicant must have at least a 3.0 grade point average (on a 4.0 scale)
4. Financial need will be considered but shall not be the determining factor in awarding the scholarship.
5. Applicant must answer all questions and have asked for letters of endorsement from two adults (see application form.)
6. Scholarships may be used only for tuition and fees required for attendance, and for course-related expenses (fees, books, supplies and equipment required for courses of instruction).

In 2017 one \$1000 Scholarship will be awarded. (This four-year scholarship will be awarded in annual allotments of \$250, which provide award winners to receive the \$250 award by providing verification of good standing and continuing to pursue their degree in either agriculture or education.

Deadline to apply is March1, 2017 to Neillsville High School Counseling Office.
