



James Brasington Theater Scholarship Application

INTRODUCTION

The James Brasington Theater Scholarship was established in May, 2005, by the family of James Brasington as a memorial to his life. James died in an automobile accident on April 28, 2005, south of Marshfield, Wisconsin. As a twenty year old college student, James was intending to become a professional actor, though he was devoted to all facets of theater and drama. He was a graduate of Marshfield High School and was attending the University of Wisconsin campus in Marshfield at the time of his death.

It is the purpose of this fund to provide worthy high school graduates who are committed to a career in theater and who wish to engage in advanced study at a college or university anywhere in the country the opportunity of receiving scholarship assistance. (Applicants who have already embarked on a collegiate career are also welcome to apply as a continuing or transfer college student.)

Criteria for the James Brasington Theater Scholarship are as follows:

- The applicant must be a graduating student at a high school or have graduated from a high school within a thirty mile radius of Marshfield, Wisconsin, or within the Marshfield Area Community Foundation's geographic service area (defined as including the communities of Marshfield, Chili, Granton, Neillsville, Loyal, Greenwood, Withee, Owen, Spencer, Unity, Colby, Abbotsford, Dorchester, Stetsonville, Medford, Stratford, Rozellville, Hewitt, Auburndale, Blenker, Milladore, Sherry, and Arpin.)
- The applicant must be scheduled to be enrolled as an undergraduate on a full-time basis at an accredited college or university during the next succeeding term. An accredited university or college is one which has been accredited by one of the following: Middle States Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools, the New England Association of Schools and Colleges, the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools, the Northwest Association of Secondary and Higher Schools, the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, or the Western Association of Schools and Colleges.
- The applicant must be majoring in or intend to major in theatre arts. (Preference will be given to applicants who demonstrate a special interest and affinity for the art of acting, although other areas of theater study will also be worthy of support.)
- Financial need will be considered but shall not be the determining factor in awarding the scholarship.
- A scholarship may be renewed for up to three years (in addition to the initial scholarship) provided that the recipient maintains an academic performance satisfactory to the Scholarship Selection Committee which will review the recipient's record each year.
- Applicants must answer all questions and have asked for letters of endorsement from two adults (see application form.)
- Scholarships may be used only for tuition and fees required for attendance, and for course-related expenses (fees, books, supplies and equipment required for courses of instruction).
